### Rationale

#### Why is it being considered?

A bid has been submitted to the Welsh Government under Reducing Class Sizes Capital Grants to permanently increase capacity at Barkers Lane CP.

Barker's Lane CP has been deemed the most suitable location to increase capacity, which should result in the reduction in class classes in Town Centre schools.

#### What need is being addressed?

Increase in town centre primary school places.

Reduction in 1st preference refusals.

Reduction in class sizes in town centre primary schools.

Increase in capacity at Barker's Lane CP

Current 1 form entry (210 capacity) with a 30 pupil Nursery

Proposed 1.5 form entry (315 capacity) with a 45 pupil Nursery

Completion of an extension at Barker's Lane CP, permanent increase in capacity at Barker's Lane CP.
